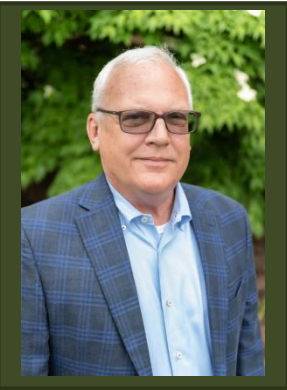

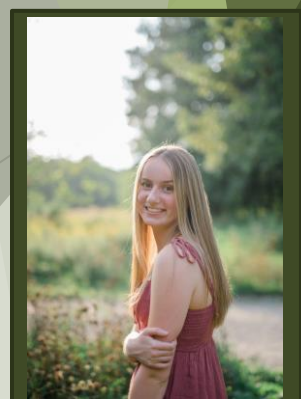

Planning Grant:

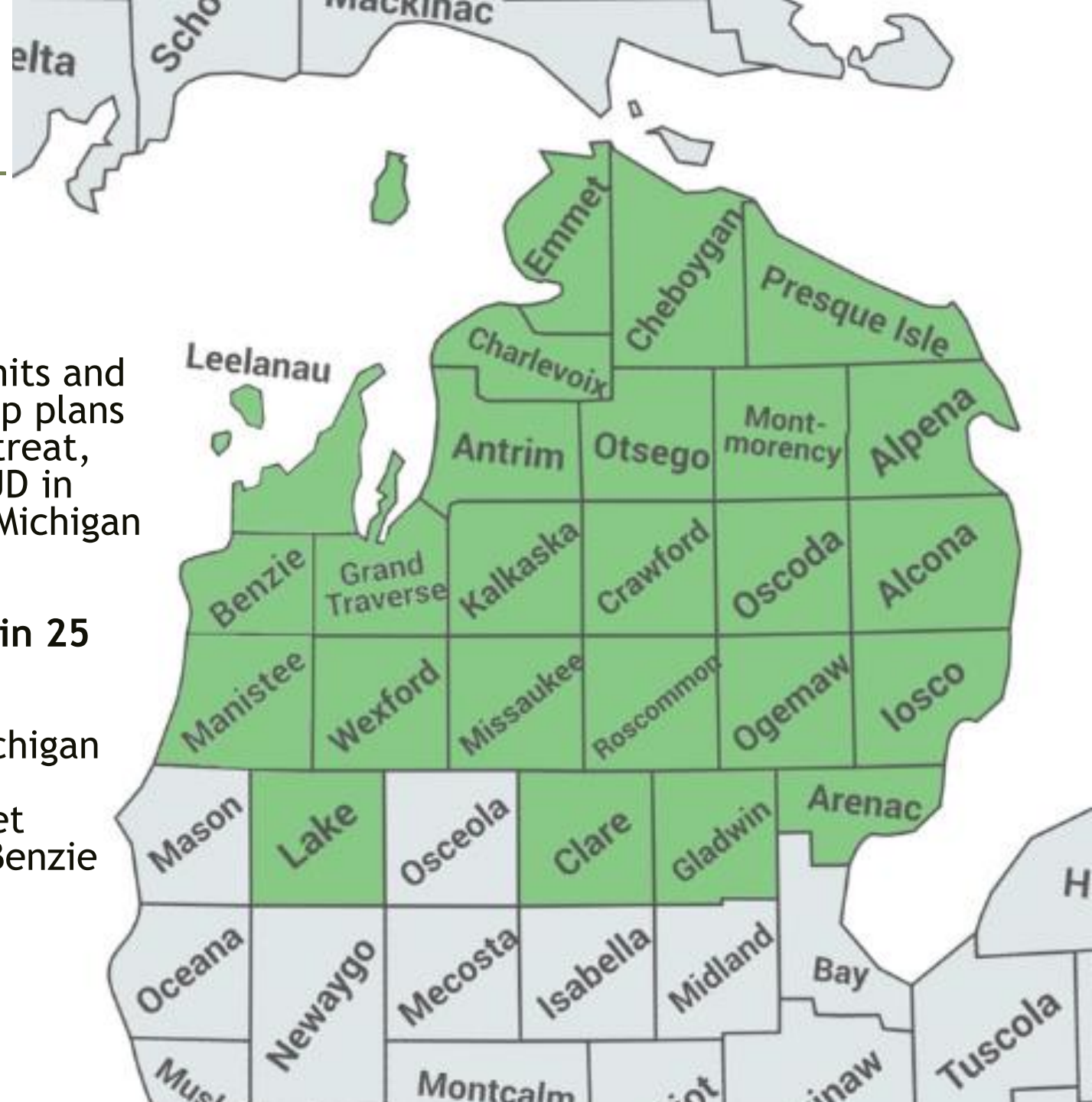

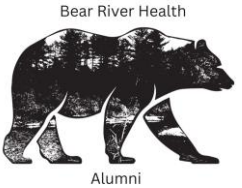
