- > 567,919 Veterans in Michigan
- Over 2/3 receive community care, not VA care
- > 55% are not connected to all their earned benefits
 - o #1 Barrier: stigma
 - #2 Barrier: "I do not feel understood by the providers who serve me."

Community providers play a vital role in ensuring Veterans receive the care they earned.



A Veteran struggling with chronic head pain and other difficulties had been to three different healthcare facilities and not one asked if he had ever served in the military. He had been in IED explosions and lost his roommate in an explosion. He was given pain meds and sent home. He never received an accurate diagnosis or relevant treatment. The Veteran died by suicide.
