Our April 24th, 2019 meeting focused on operations of the Rural Health Clinic including Billing and Coding Basics, Top Ten Deficiencies and RHC Modernization ACT. “

The network uses **Quality Health Indicators (QHi)** as its, quality benchmarking program. We currently have 71 RHC clinics enrolled, with 11 actively reporting. – We need to really start getting clinics to report their data. Please remember to ask for assistance when needed.

The network continues to grow the financial benchmarking capabilities with the addition of Lilypad’s **Practice Operations National Database (“POND”)**. We currently have 74 clinics enrolled. This is sure to be a great financial benchmarking tool for the clinics.
